What personally identifiable information does the Indigo Group collect?

If you are a customer we will collect:

Registration information that you provide when enrolling your child/young person in our care via telephone, online or in person. This information may include your identity and contact information, your financial details to enable payment of fees, your child/young person's name, date of birth, gender, allergies, food restrictions, special needs, doctors information, emergency contact details and other information to provide high quality care.

If you are a visitor we will collect:

Contact information such as name, email address, telephone number.

Where does The indigo Group store personally identifiable information?

Electronic information: The electronic personal information we collect will be stored and processed on electronic systems operated by us and by third party.

Hardcopy Information: The hardcopy information we collect is securely locked away and only accessed by personnel in the course of their duties on behalf of The Indigo Group.

Information we collect is stored in the UK or in the European Economic Area.

The Indigo Group considers your personal information confidential and does not sell it to others.

Agents and Service providers:

We sometimes employ or contract with other companies and individuals to perform functions on our behalf, such as supporting our systems infrastructure, providing recruiting services, taking care of our confidential waste and providing archiving solutions for our data. These parties are under a legal obligation to use your personal information as solely provided in the contractual services to The Indigo Group.

Some of our our current suppliers include providers such as Sage Accounts and Sage Payroll, Famly Software and RGB Information Technology who keep our Servers secure and provide IT support. We may also share your information with our HR support, legal and accounting advisers. If we enter into discussions about partnering with another organisation or selling part of our organisation or operations, we may also share your information (but only what is required and often only on an anonymous basis) for the purposes of assessing those prospects or processing that sale.

How can you access or update your personal information?

Your Legal rights:

In certain circumstances, you have rights under data protection laws in relation to your personal data:

- Request access to your personal data
- Request correction of your personal data
- Request erasure of your personal data
- Object to processing of your personal data
- Request restriction of processing your personal data
- Request transfer of your personal data
- Right to withdraw consent.

What we may need from you

We may need to request specific information from you to help us confirm your identity and ensure your right to access your personal data (or to exercise any of your other rights). Time limit to respond

We try to respond to all legitimate requests within one month. Occasionally it could take us longer than a month if your request is particularly complex or you have made a number of requests. In this case, we will notify you and keep you updated.

How does The Indigo Group protect my personal information?

The Indigo Group places a high priority on the security of your information.

We take the security of your data seriously. We have internal policies and controls in place to ensure that your data is not lost, accidentally destroyed, misused or disclosed, and is not accessed except by our employees in the proper performance of their duties

Data Retention:

The Indigo Group shall not keep your personal data for longer than is necessary for the purpose we obtained it for and will dispose of it in a secure way when no longer needed for that purpose.
